## **Fireside Chat: Marconi in NJ**

In 1913 at the intersection of JFK Boulevard and Easton Avenue in Somerset, NJ, ground was broken for an installation that would help shape the course of history. Join us for an interesting afternoon as we learn about inventor, electrical engineer, businessman, entrepreneur, Nobel Prize in Physics winner and radio transmission pioneer Guglielmo Marconi.

Our speaker, Alex Kucsma, is a former Councilman and Mayor of Franklin Township, and for four decades has taught Composition, American Literature and Creative Writing at the County College of Morris. He is a playwright and member of the Dramatist Guild, writing under the name of John Glennville. Additionally, in 2013 he was named President of the Marconi Foundation of Franklin Township.
