A naturalist from the Somerset County Parks Commission's Environmental Education Center will be at the Hageman Farm to teach us all about our lovely little backyard buddies. The first hour takes place in the amazing horse barn, where you will learn about the fundamentals of backyard birdwatching, basic identification skills, what to feed backyard birds, as well as where and when to place your feeders.



During the second hour you will venture out into the field to practice what you just learned. Bring your binoculars, field guides, and cameras! There is a colony of barn swallows that live under the horse barn, and there have been blue bird sightings (among many other types of birds). Surrounded by open fields and trees, the Hageman Farm is ideal for bird watching!!!

This event will be held on Sunday, Jun 12, 2022 from 2-4 pm at the historic Hageman House, 209 South Middlebush Road, Franklin Township, NJ. The fee for attending is \$12 for members and \$15 for non-members. This event is for ages 12 and over, and minors must be accompanied by an adult.
